Collaborate dialogue between First Nations leadership, rights holders and organizations to

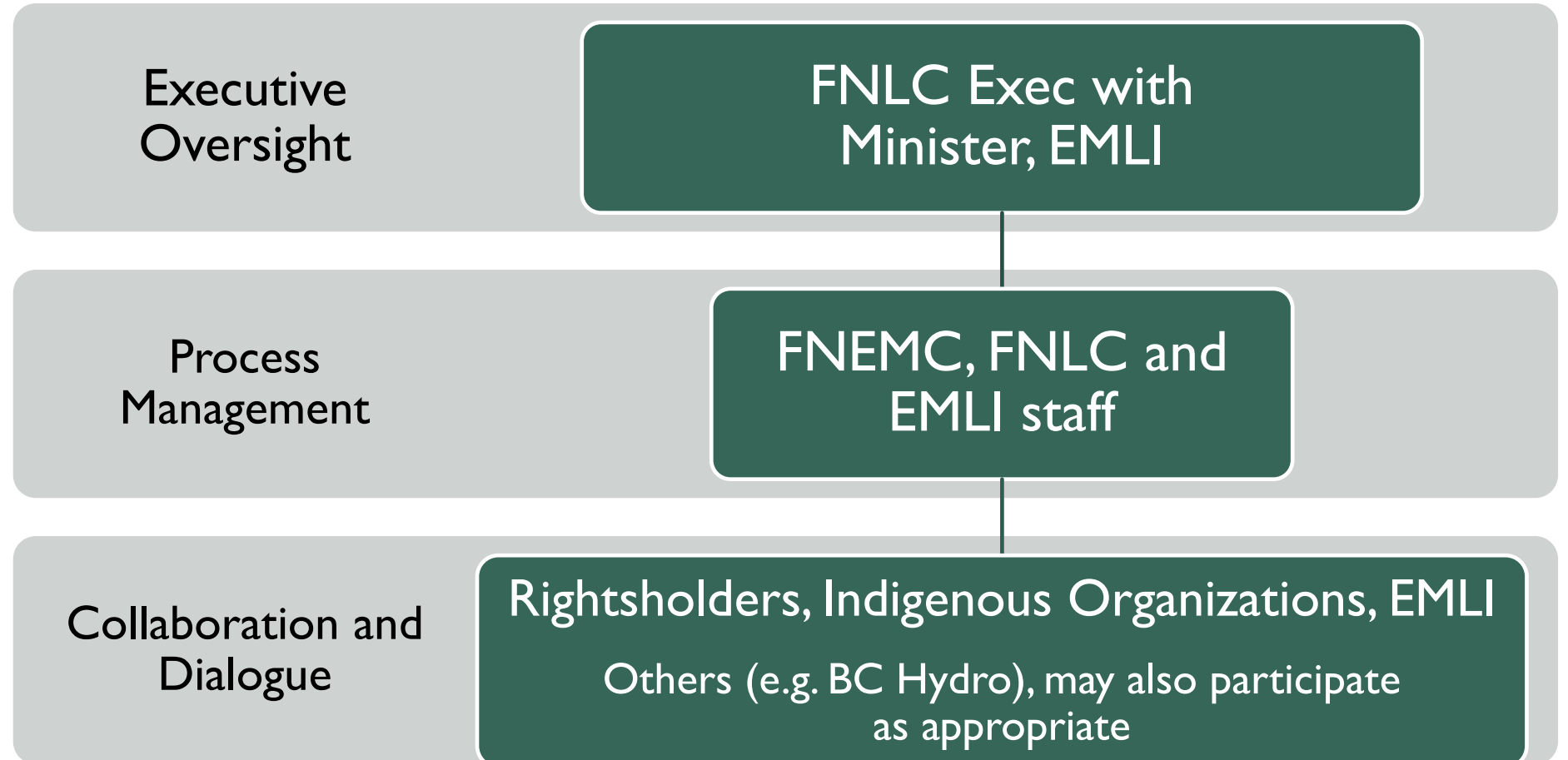
- position First Nations to fully participate in current and future opportunities in British Columbia's clean energy sector

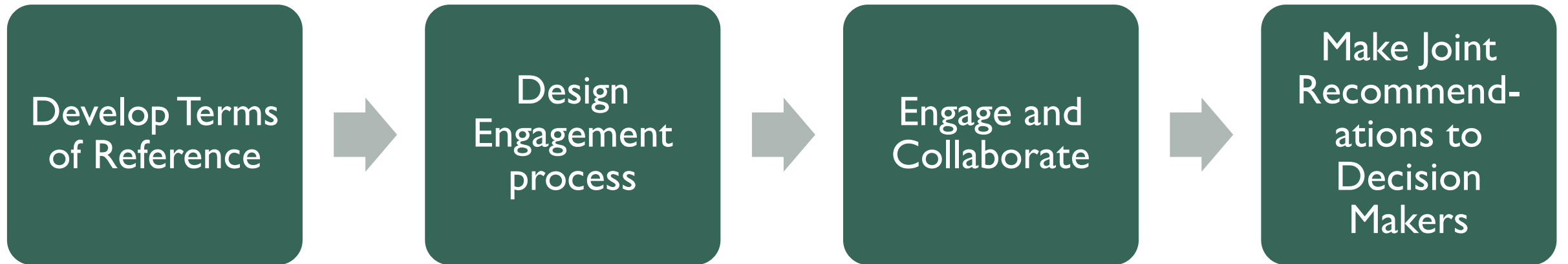

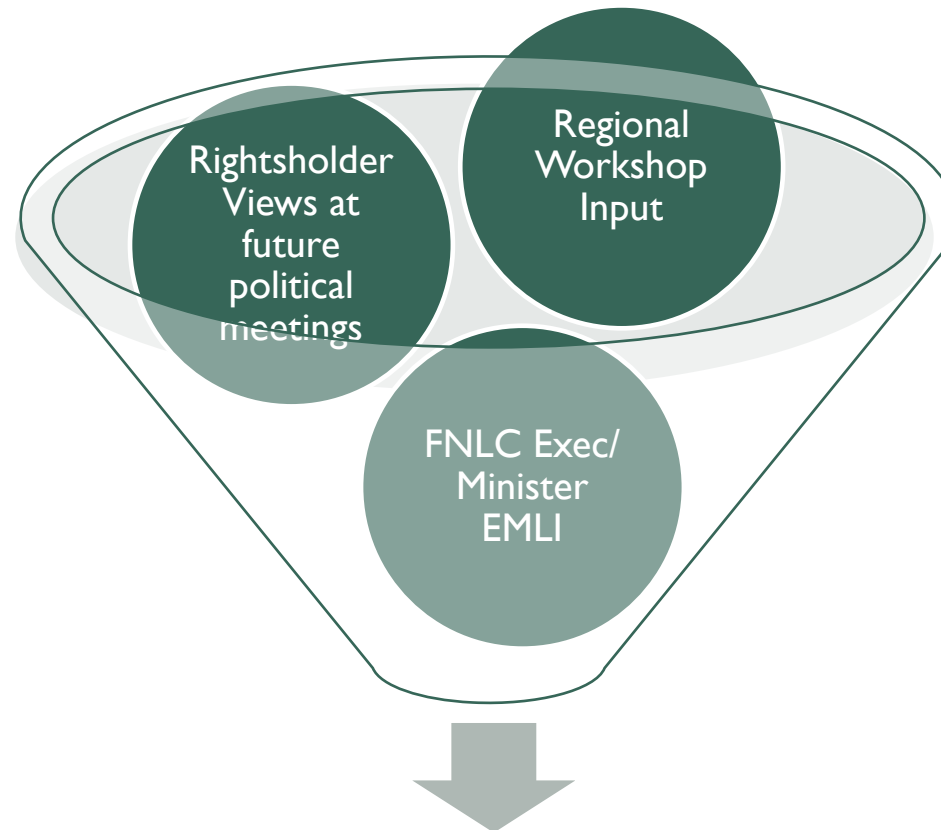
