CleanBC Go Electric EV Charger Rebate Program



REBATES FOR HOME AND WORKPLACE CHARGING

Increased rebate offers are available for B.C. Indigenous communities, businesses, and individuals to purchase and install eligible Level 2 charging stations (funding is available on a first-come first served basis while funding lasts):

- Single Family Home Rebate: Up to 75% of project costs to a maximum of \$750. Individual residents are eligible to apply for rebates at their primary residence.
- Multi-Unit Residential Building rebate: Up to 75% of project costs to a maximum of \$4,500 per charger.
- Workplace rebate: Up to 75% of project costs to a maximum of \$4,000 per charger.

EV READY REBATES

EV Ready rebates are also available for strata corporations, building owners and co-operative boards to support multi-unit residential buildings future proof their buildings on a first-come first-served basis while funding lasts:

- EV Ready plan rebate: Up to 75% of project costs, to a maximum of \$3,000, to develop an EV Ready plan, which is a building specific strategy that provides a minimum of one electrified parking stall per resident.
- EV Ready infrastructure rebate: Up to 50% of the electrical infrastructure and installation costs as recommended in the EV Ready plan, to a maximum of \$600 per parking stall with a project maximum of \$120,000.

Plug In BC offers up to five hours of free planning assistance from an EV charging advisor, who can help can guide you through the process of setting up EV charging stations at your building.


