

CleanBC Go Electric Fleet Charging Program



REBATES FOR FLEET CHARGING STATIONS

Increased rebate offers are available for B.C. Indigenous communities and businesses to purchase and install eligible Level 2 and direct current fast charger (DCFC) charging stations for their fleets:





All program rebates are available on a first-come first served basis while funding lasts.

PRE-APPROVAL REQUIRED

Applicants must apply for pre-approval to receive Level 2 and DCFC charging station rebates. To be eligible, applicants must be located in B.C. and provide proof of current ownership or purchase order to acquire electric fleet vehicles.

B.C Indigenous communities and businesses that receive electrical service from BC Hydro can apply for support with fleet assessments, EV infrastructure assessments, and electrical infrastructure upgrades through BC Hydro's Fleet Electrification program.



EV REBATES

B.C. Indigenous communities and businesses that receive electrical service from FortisBC are eligible for increased rebates for fleet assessments, EV infrastructure assessments, and electrical infrastructure upgrades:

- Fleet assessments: Up to 75% of project costs to a maximum of \$50,000
- EV infrastructure assessments: Up to 75% of project costs to a maximum of \$5,000
- Electrical infrastructure upgrades: Up to 75% of project costs to a maximum of \$25,000

The Fleet Advisor can guide and support fleets through the electrification process, including the steps required to apply for rebates through the CleanBC Go Electric Fleet Charging Program.
