

# CleanBC Go Electric Rebates Program



## SIX CATEGORIES OF REBATES

Go Electric Rebates (GER) provides rebates across six categories, ranging from \$2,000 to \$150,000 per vehicle, depending on the category:

- Rebate categories include electric motorcycles, cargo e-bikes, utility vehicles, medium- and heavy-duty vehicles, airport and port specialty vehicles, and low-speed vehicles.
- Businesses, fleets, and non-profit organizations are eligible to apply for rebates across all categories. Individual applicants qualify for rebates on electric motorcycles and neighborhood zero-emission vehicles.
- Rebates are awarded on a first-come, first-served basis, subject to the availability of program funding.



## INCREASED REBATES

Increased rebate offerings are available for Indigenous communities and local governments in British Columbia.

- Applicants that are local or Indigenous governments, or their respective departments or agencies, may combine provincial and federal rebates to cover up to 100% of total project costs. For all other applicants, the combined funding is limited to a maximum of 75% of eligible project costs.





## REBATES PROVIDED POST-PURCHASE

Rebates through GER are provided post-purchase. Applicants must have completed their vehicle purchase and taken delivery of their vehicle to apply and receive a rebate.



## ELIGIBILITY



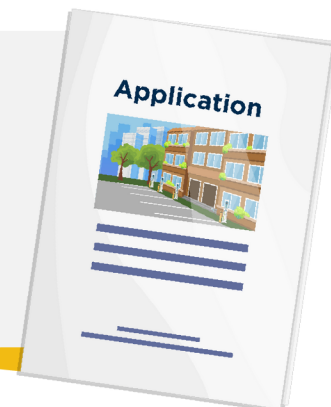
Each organization is eligible for up to 10 rebates per calendar year for on-road medium- and heavy-duty vehicles and certain airport and port specialty vehicles.
